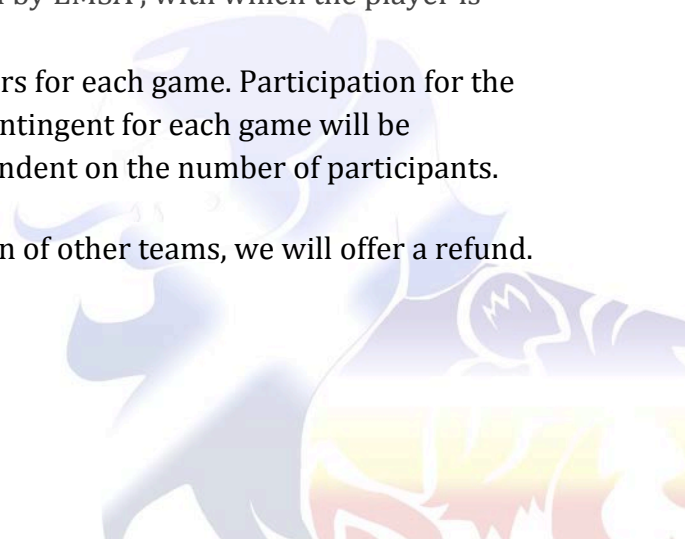

- Guest team: A player/team from any Asian society from the University of Edinburgh with an approved member pass who is invited by EMSA, with which the player is participating in a particular event
- Contingents may send as many teams of players for each game. Participation for the first registered team/player from the same contingent for each game will be prioritised. The fate of the others will be dependent on the number of participants.

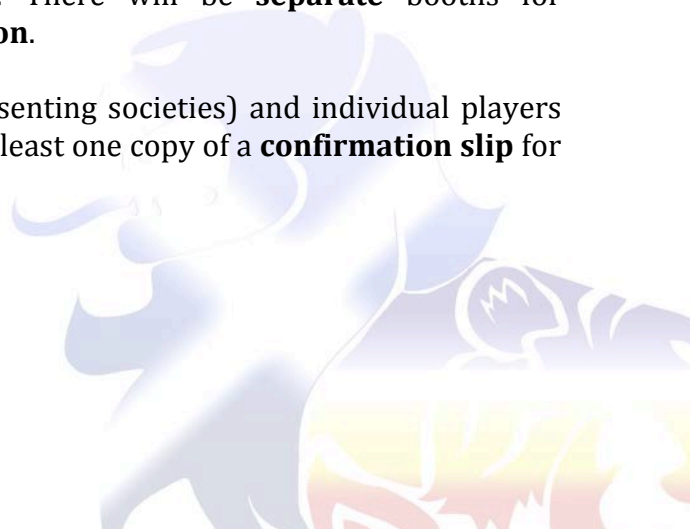

3. Upon confirmation of payment, an official receipt and confirmation slip containing a reference number will be sent to you via email. **Please print this out and submit it to the person-in-charge at the Registrations booth on the day of the event**
4. We will inform you if you have managed to attain all/any of the slots for the games you wish to participate in on 25<sup>th</sup> October 2011 (Tuesday). NB: First teams will definitely be given a slot. However, consecutive teams signed up for the same sport will be designated a slot depending on participation rate. If there are no available slots left, you will be refunded. A new receipt and confirmation slip will then be issued.
5. Print out the confirmation slip and receipt. This slip is a proof of registration and must be brought along and presented upon registration on the day of the event itself.

## **On the day of the event...**

1. Heads of Contingent and Team Captains are required to register at the **Registration booths** near the entrance/reception of MSC. There will be **separate** booths for **contingency registration** and **games registration**.
2. All Heads of Contingents (for participants representing societies) and individual players (not representing any society) shall hold on to at least one copy of a **confirmation slip** for the purpose of identification.

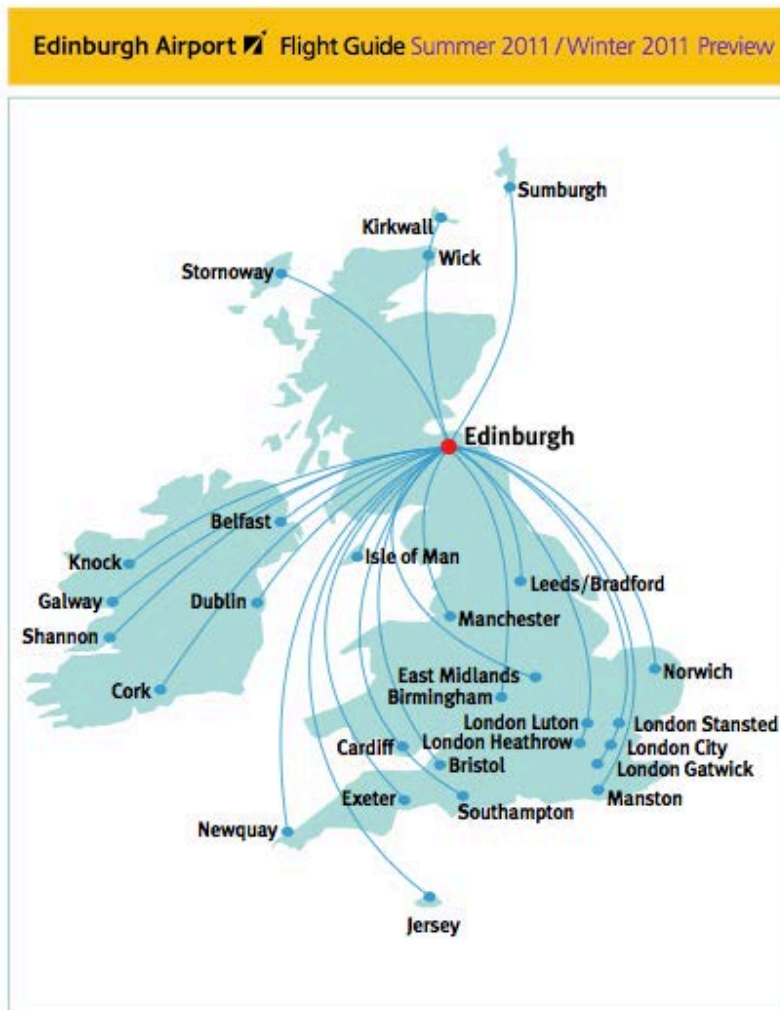

### By plane



**Edinburgh International Airport** is served by a variety of international airlines and low-cost carriers, including British Airways, EasyJet and Flybe. The airport is located 12km west of the city centre.

The **Airlink 100** operates a frequent bus service between Edinburgh Airport and the city centre. Journey time is about 30 minutes and tickets cost £3.50 single and £6.00 return.

Taxis are also widely available at the airport and cost around £15 to the city centre.

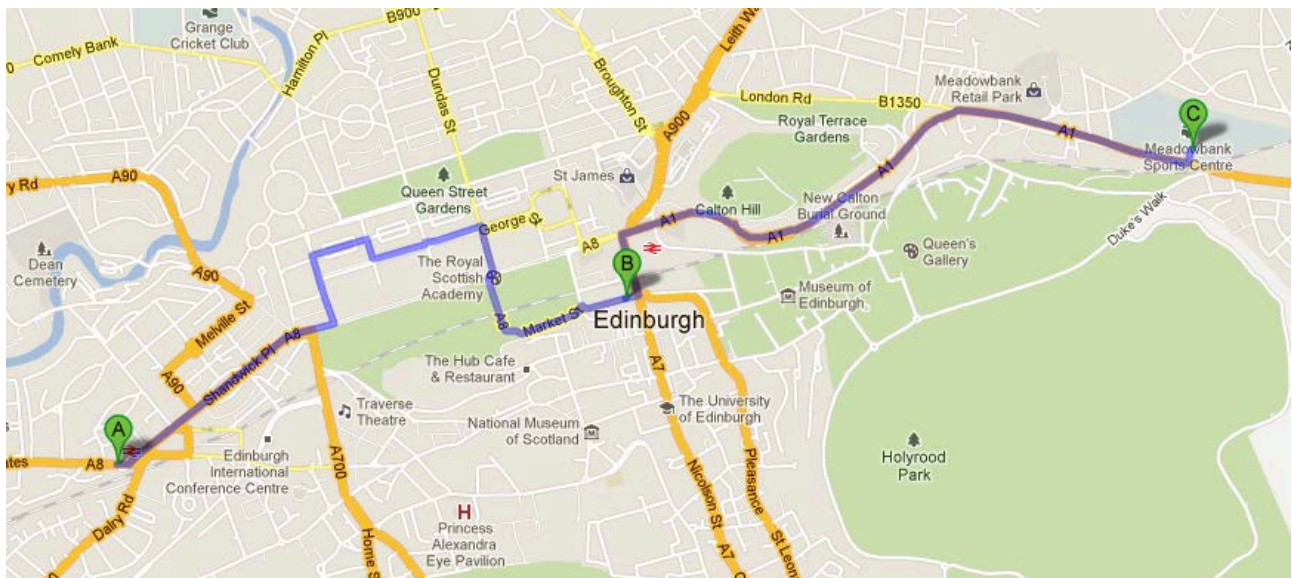

B – Waverley Station

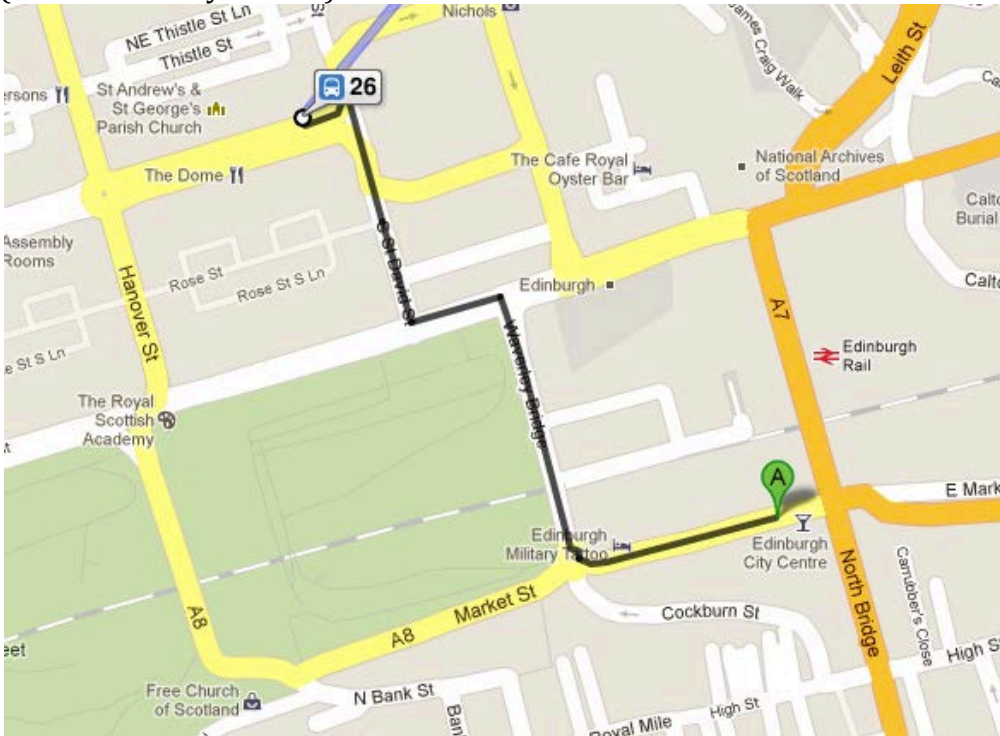
C – Meadowbank Sports Centre



To get around by bus...

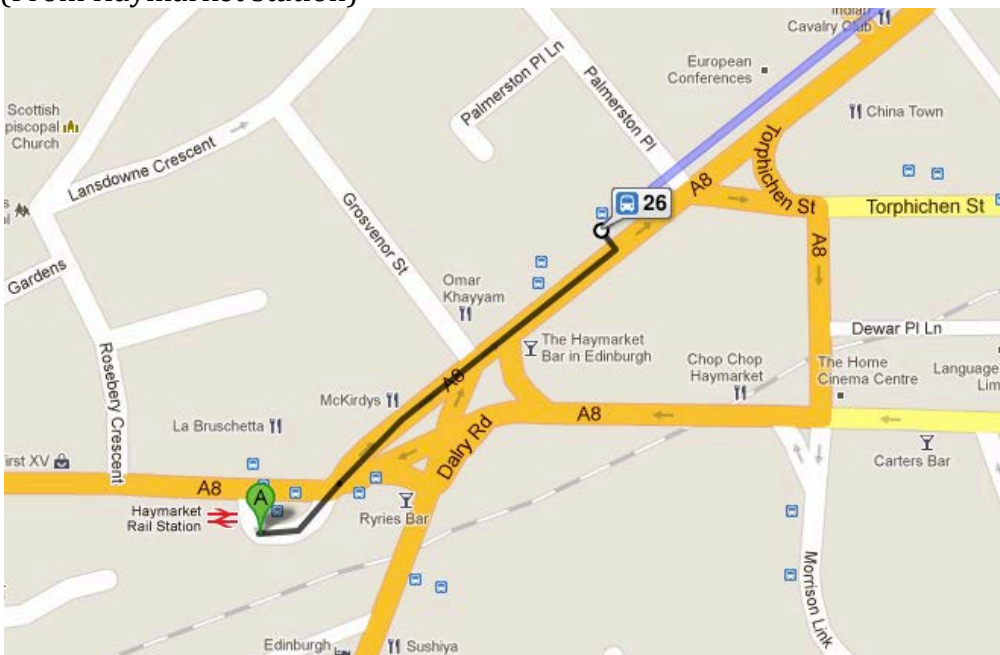
A single (one-way) bus fare costs £1.30 per person, where as a day ticket costs £3.20.

- ❖ Make sure you bring umbrellas and proper attire in case of bad weather (highly probable in Scotland!).
